Undergraduate Initial Teacher Licensure

Are you currently hired as an Instructional Assistant working in a multiple subjects/elementary setting? Are you interested in completing a bachelor's degree and becoming a classroom teacher?

Eastern Oregon University is offering an undergraduate program designed specifically for the Oregon Instructional Assistant (IA). IA Teacher Candidates can remain in their elementary IA positions throughout the entire program, via hybrid courses and a modified student teaching experience.

Program Highlights:

- **Earn your Undergraduate Elementary Education degree** and work towards Oregon K-12 licensure, with a multiple subjects endorsement, while maintaining your position as an Instructional Assistant.
- **Individualized advising** with program specialists to develop streamlined education plans.
- **Collaborative learning environment** taking teaching classes as part of a two-year cohort.
- **Study where you are** with courses offered virtually in the evenings, from the comfort of your own home.
- **Course textbooks** are provided, further reducing the overall program cost to the IA teacher candidates.
- **District Letter of Support** replaces the formal undergraduate program application process.
- **Lowest tuition costs** of all public universities in Oregon.
- **Diverse Classroom Library** is provided to all program completers for their own classrooms.
